BVARC also holds a Public Service Net each Monday at 8:00 p.m. on the on the 145.47 (minus offset, tone 123.0) and a Rag Chew Net each Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. on 3910 KHz +/- 3 KHz. BVARC also organizes the Greater Houston Hamfest on the first weekend of March.
