The April meeting will be a presentation on FreeDV Digital Voice for HF. Walter Holmes, K5WH, will explain the format as well as the new modes and future enhancements. “FreeDV is a Digital Voice mode for HF radio. You can run FreeDV using a free GUI application for Windows, Linux and OSX that allows any SSB radio to be used for low bit rate digital voice.”

“FreeDV is being developed by an international team of radio amateurs working together on coding, design, user interface and testing. FreeDV is open-source software, released under the GNU Lesser Public License version 2.1. The modems and Codec 2 speech codec used in FreeDV are also open source.”
