

Bylaws Revisions Pass

All of the bylaws changed proposed in the previous newsletter passed at the December 12th membership meeting. A summary of the changes follows.

- Reduction of At-Large Board of Director from 3 members to 2 members.
- 2. Change the term of the officers to 2 years having staggered periods. Beginning in 2003 the office of President, Recording Secretary and one of the Atlarge directors will be elected. The following year the election will be for Vice President, Corresponding Secretary/Treasury, and the other At-
- large Director. Include the Past President as an At Large director.
- Add a student membership to the classes of members with reduced membership dues.
- 5. Allow for a yearly review of the Life Membership rate by the board.
- 6. Increase the Individual membership dues to \$20.00 per year.
